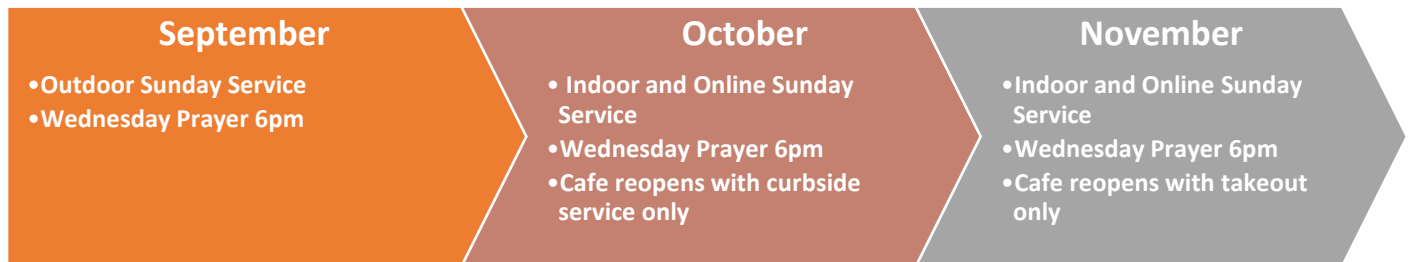


PAOG COVID-19 Bounce Back Plan

Greetings PAOG Family and Community,

The past month of regathering has been exciting! We've been able to worship safely and be a blessing to our neighbors. So far, despite all that's transpiring, we are staying on mission. We continue to pray and worked to plan and prioritize safe and healthy worship, prayer, and fellowship.

We will continue to gather in reduced fashion the remainder of 2020. Please review the updated Phases below. Your support and patience is necessary for our collective success.



What we need from you:

1. Return to the church free of COVID-19 symptoms. Self-quarantine if you've recently been in large crowds or knowingly have been in contact with someone with COVID symptoms. Call the church to have a member of the altar care team or a leader reach out to you with love and prayer.
2. Register through Eventbrite. Seating is first come, first served.
3. While outdoors, tents will be provided. Seating will also be provided, but with limited capacity due to the need for physical distancing.
4. Participate in temperature/health screening upon parking lot entry.
5. Wear a mask.
6. Follow seating directions of ushers.
7. Observe 6 feet of physical/social distancing.
8. Comply with all signage and markings posted throughout the building, including restrooms.
9. Attendees must leave immediately after service and only socialize on the parking lot if desired.

Reminders:

1. People, while symptom free, may still be a carrier of COVID-19.
2. The virus is spread through respiratory droplets from an infectious person, often when they cough or sneeze. During normal conversation, six feet of space is sufficient distance for droplets to fall off. During praise and worship or corporate prayer, droplets will spread much further, requiring a greater space of distance.
3. According to the CDC, people over 65 or with serious underlying health conditions are considered at greater risk of severe illness with COVID-19.

Fall Phase 1: (September) Gathering size of 150-175 people onsite.

- a. Meet Outdoors on the parking lot and online (FB Live) for worship service.
- b. Registration required.
- c. Masks required.
- d. Modified Office Hours resume, 10am-3pm Mon-Thurs; Friday by appt.
- e. Digital platforms utilized for group gatherings (e.g., YTH EVO; Life Groups; The Sisterhood; Jesus Fraternity; etc.)

Fall Phase 2: (October) Gathering size of 150-175 people onsite.

- a. Registration required.
- b. Worship service onsite in the sanctuary and online (FB Live).
- c. Parking Lot attendance for radio broadcast (700 AM) allowed until lot is at capacity.
- d. Masks required for those who worship inside as well as other safety measures.
- e. Regular Office Hours resume, 9am-5pm Mon-Thurs; Friday by appt.
- f. Digital platforms utilized for group gatherings (e.g., YTH EVO; Life Groups; The Sisterhood; Jesus Fraternity; etc.)

Fall Phase 3: (November) Gathering size of 150-175 people onsite.

- a. Registration required.
- b. Worship service onsite in the sanctuary and online (FB Live).
- c. Parking Lot attendance for radio broadcast (700 AM) allowed until lot is at capacity.
- d. Masks required for those who worship inside as well as other safety measures.
- e. Regular Office Hours resume, 9am-5pm Mon-Thurs; Friday by appt.
- f. Digital platforms utilized for group gatherings (e.g., YTH EVO; Life Groups; The Sisterhood; Jesus Fraternity; etc.)
- g. Teams can meet onsite for meetings by reservation with safety protocols implemented.

Fall Phase 4: (December) Gathering size of 175-200 people onsite.

- a. Registration required.
- b. Worship service onsite in the sanctuary and online (FB Live).
- c. Parking Lot attendance for radio broadcast (700 AM) allowed until lot is at capacity.
- d. Masks required for those who worship inside as well as other safety measures.
- e. Regular Office Hours resume, 9am-5pm Mon-Thurs; Friday by appt.
- f. Digital platforms utilized for group gatherings (e.g., YTH EVO; Life Groups; The Sisterhood; Jesus Fraternity; etc.)
- g. Teams can meet onsite for meetings by reservation with safety protocols implemented.
