



Ambassadors are representatives sent from their home country/kingdom, to a foreign territory, to serve and promote the interests of their homeland. Every born-again believer is an ambassador for Christ (2 Corinthians 5:20). This means that upon receiving salvation, they are assigned to represent the Kingdom of Heaven in the earth through the ministry of reconciliation. In other words, Ambassadors are tasked with calling people back to God (2 Corinthians 5:21). Ambassadors are placed in specific territories and only released when the government changes their assignment. Neighborhoods, workplaces, business/industry, school, and other places of people activity are territories or mission fields for the ministry of reconciliation.
