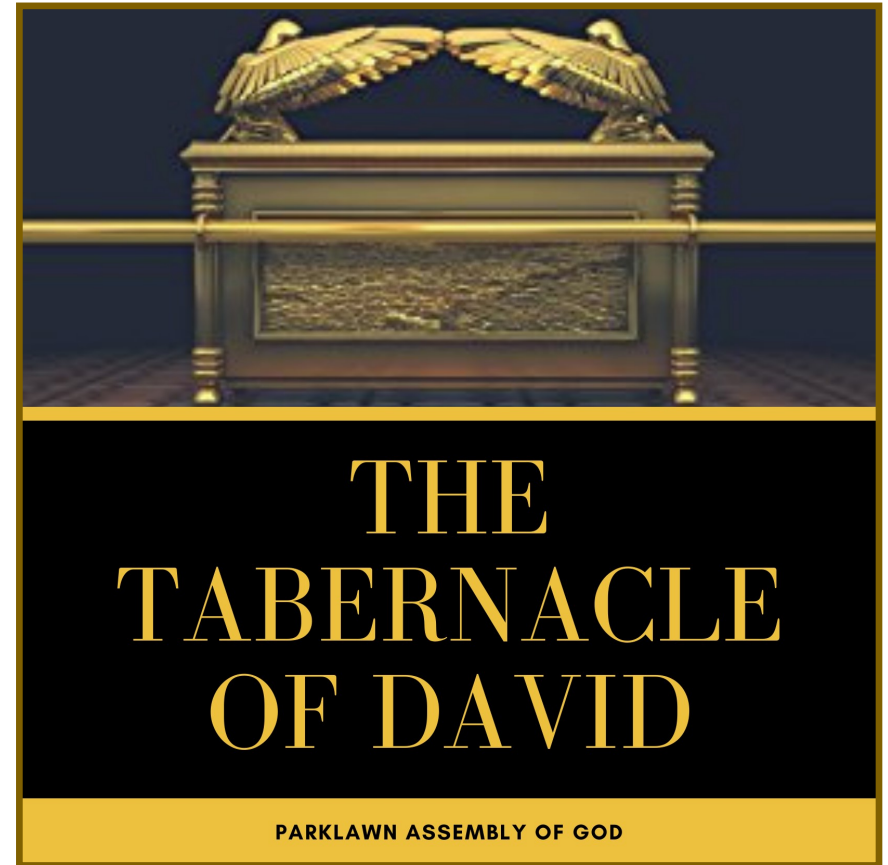
Offertory Confession
