So then let us cast off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light. <sup>13</sup>Let us walk properly as in the daytime, not in orgies and drunkenness, not in sexual immorality and sensuality, not in quarreling and jealousy. <sup>14</sup>But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to gratify its desires.

  - i. *Jesus is the wisdom of God (1 Corinthians 1:30; Proverbs 8:22-31)*

- ii. *Jesus has treasures of wisdom and knowledge (Col.2:3, KJV)*
- iii. **Proverbs 3:13-20 (NIV)** <sup>13</sup>Blessed are those who find wisdom, those who gain understanding, <sup>14</sup>for she is more profitable than silver and yields better returns than gold <sup>15</sup>She is more precious than rubies; nothing you desire can compare with her. Long life is in her right hand; in her left hand are riches and honor. Her ways are pleasant ways, and all her paths are peace. She is a tree of life to those who take hold of her; those who hold her fast will be blessed. By wisdom the LORD laid the earth's foundations, by understanding he set the heavens in place; By his knowledge the watery depths were divided, and the clouds let drop the dew.
- iv. **Proverbs 2:2 (NLT)** *"Tune your ears to wisdom. Concentrate on understanding."*
- v. **Ecclesiastes 7:11-12 (NLT)** <sup>11</sup>Wisdom is even better when you have money. Both are a benefit as you go through life. Wisdom and money can get you almost anything, but only wisdom can save your life.
- vi. **Ecclesiastes 7:19 (NLT)** <sup>19</sup>One wise person is stronger than ten leading citizens of a town!
- vii. **Ecclesiastes 10:11-12 (NLT)** <sup>10</sup>Using a dull ax requires great strength, so sharpen the blade. That's the value of wisdom; it helps you succeed.
- viii. **Ecclesiastes 9:13-18 (NLT)** Here is another bit of wisdom that has impressed me as I have watched the way our world works. <sup>14</sup>There was a small town with only a few people, and a great king came with his army and besieged it. <sup>15</sup>A poor, wise man knew how to save the town, and so it was rescued. But afterward no one thought to thank him. <sup>16</sup>So even though wisdom is better than strength, those who are wise will be despised if they are poor. What they say will not be appreciated for long. Better to hear the quiet words of a wise person than the shouts of a foolish king. Better to have wisdom than weapons of war, but one sinner can destroy much that is good.

## 6. Wisdom, Revelation and Elevation

- a. **Joseph had unusual wisdom. (Acts 7:10, NLT)**
- b. **Pharaoh's Dream led to a demand for Joseph's supply. (Gen. 41)**
  - i. "Pharaoh sent for Joseph at once and he was quickly brought from the prison... Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, "I had a dream last night, and no one here can tell me what it means. *But I have heard that when you hear about a dream you can interpret it.* "It is beyond my power to do this," Joseph replied. "But God can tell you what it means and set you at ease." (v.14-16)
  - ii. "This will happen just as I have described it, for God has revealed to Pharaoh in advance what he is about to do. (v.28)

iii. “As for having two similar dreams, it means that these events have been decreed by God, and he will soon make them happen. Therefore, Pharaoh should find an intelligent and wise man and put him in charge of the entire land of Egypt. <sup>34</sup>Then Pharaoh should appoint supervisors over the land and let them collect one-fifth of all the crops during the seven good years. <sup>35</sup>Have them gather all the food produced in the good years that are just ahead and bring it to Pharaoh’s storehouses. Store it away, and guard it so there will be food in the cities. <sup>36</sup>That way there will be enough to eat when the seven years of famine come to the land of Egypt. Otherwise this famine will destroy the land.” (v.32-36)

iv. **Joseph Made Ruler of Egypt**

Joseph’s suggestions were well received by Pharaoh and his officials. <sup>38</sup>So Pharaoh asked his officials, “Can we find anyone else like this man so obviously filled with the spirit of God?” <sup>39</sup>Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, “Since God has revealed the meaning of the dreams to you, clearly no one else is as intelligent or wise as you are. <sup>40</sup>You will be in charge of my court, and all my people will take orders from you. Only I, sitting on my throne, will have a rank higher than yours.”(v.37-40)

“And as for having two similar dreams, it means that these events have been decreed by God, and he will soon make them happen. Therefore, Pharaoh should find an intelligent and wise man and put him in charge of the entire land of Egypt. <sup>34</sup>Then Pharaoh should appoint supervisors over the land and let them collect one-fifth of all the crops during the seven good years. <sup>35</sup>Have them gather all the food produced in the good years that are just ahead and bring it to Pharaoh’s storehouses. **Joseph Made Ruler of Egypt**

v. And all the world came to Egypt to buy grain from Joseph, because the famine was severe everywhere. (v. 57)
