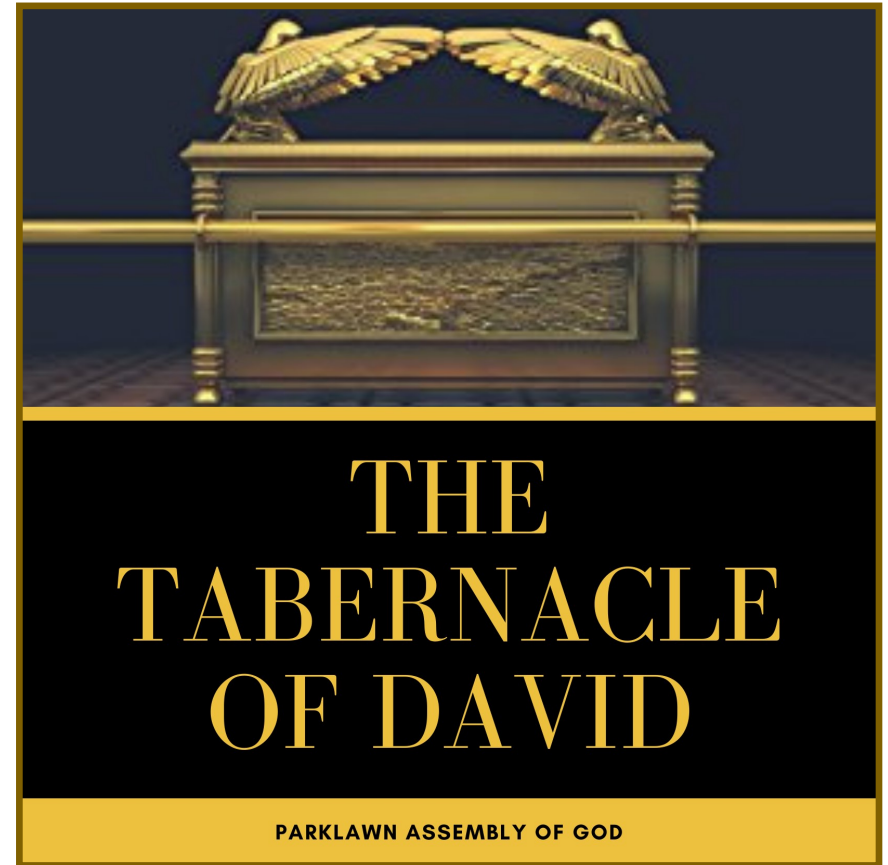
Offertory Confession
